



# RESTORATIVE PRACTICE (RP)



#### **Restorative Questions to Address Harm**

- What happened?
- · What were you thinking of at the time?
- What have you thought about it since?
- · Who has been affected and in what way?
- How could things have been done differently?
- What do you think needs to happen next?

- Information and resources for teaching RP.
- RP is based primarily on a set of core values and the explicit promotion and enhancement of particular skills such as the ability to empathise and to find solutions to specific problems.






## FUSE ANTI-BULLYING LESSONS

- Consists of a suite of lessons and accompanying resources facilitated by teachers in a classroom setting.






# SHIELD ANTI-BULLYING PROGRAMME

- Organisations are encouraged to work through the Shield Self-Evaluation Tool and to receive upon review and support by ISPCC Shield Status for their organisation.








## DIGITAL WELLBEING LESSONS




